

What is Canada Child Benefit CCB

The Canada child benefit (CCB)

- is a tax-free monthly payment made to eligible families to help them with the cost of raising children under 18 years of age.
- The CCB might include the child disability benefit and any related provincial and territorial programs.
- The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) uses information from your income tax and benefit return to calculate how much your CCB payments will be. To get the CCB, you have to file your return every year, even if you did not have income in the year. If you have a spouse or common-law partner, they also have to file a return every year.
- Benefits are paid over a 12-month period from July of one year to June of the next year. Your benefit payments will be recalculated every July based on information from you and your spouse's (if applicable) income tax and benefit returns from the previous year.

Eligibility

- To be eligible for the Canada child benefit (CCB), you must meet all of the following conditions:
 - \circ You must live with the child, and the child must be under 18 years of age.
 - You must be primarily responsible for the care and upbringing of the child.
 - You must be a resident of Canada for tax purposes.
 - You **or** your spouse or common-law partner must be:
 - a Canadian citizen/ a permanent resident/ a protected person/ a temporary resident who has lived in Canada for the previous 18

months, and who has a valid permit in the 19th month/ an Indian within the meaning of the Indian Act

When to Apply

- Apply for the CCB as soon as possible after:
 - o your child is born
 - o a child starts to live with you
 - you or your spouse or common-law partner meet the eligibility conditions
- CCB payments can begin the month after you become eligible, as long as you are still eligible at the beginning of the current month.
